Eligibility:

Selection Process:

Scholarship recipients will be selected based on a overall review of their academic performance, financial need, extracurricular activities, community involvement and essay response.

Application Process:

To apply, student members must complete the attached Scholarship Application in full. The signed Application must be submitted to the address below, **along with:**

- A recent copy of the student's high school transcript (SAT, ACT scores may be included on transcript)
- Letter of acceptance to the College or University.
